Despite links branding, an undulating cliff/hill-top course, whose greatest quality is its stunning views over Gibraltar. Combination of small greens and wind can result in high scores. Tougher than its card suggests, with a few demanding carries, some over water. Much improved by revised routing from excellent new 19th.

Generally open holes with some well-placed, traditional-feel bunkering, running across relatively level ground to start and finish. In between, undulating holes flow across two valleys astride a residential ridge, in places inviting spectacular shots. Often large, reasonably undulating greens and attractive water. Confusingly, this entertaining course often has more of a Scottish links feel than Alcaidesa Links does.
