With sculpted and beautifully manicured fairways, a lush parkland layout often lined with palms, all set against backdrops of sublime views of the creek (over which one tee is set), residences and hotel (part of front 9), and occasional freeway resonance. Add generally well-bunkered greens with rather more undulations than first meet the eye, waste bunkers, water hazards, wildlife and an iconic clubhouse. The sum: one of the most attractive courses in Dubai – and no walkover, either.

✈ Dubai. Exit airport following signs for Al Rashidiya. After 500m, approaching first lights, r onto sliproad leading to Marrakesh St, for approx. 1km. 200m after 1st St (to r), take sliproad r onto Umm Ramool Rd. Passing and ignoring ext r for Akshood Bridge, you will soon see trees (marking boundary of the course) to l of the highway you are on. Once past the course, take the next L-turn and follow signs to club on r. (N.B. this is not the shortest route to the club from the airport, but, given ongoing major roadworks, the simplest. These directions may not be up to date, but the even the roadworks signs give clear directions to the club.)
