



What the THE POWER RANKING OF GOLF COURSES says Earth ★

An emphatic statement: a heavily-bunkered, stylised, tough, strategic course within residential developments (which should soften on maturity). Lined with rough and shrubs set in striking, earth-red, eco-efficient mulch, fairways run down and back up in different directions through gentle valleys from the vast clubhouse. Large, long occasionally angled, raised and/or saddled undulating greens (edged in places with short grass run-off slopes) will test short games from stars to rabbits. Not afraid to make a couple of holes semi-blind from the tee, Norman varies the pace, applying increasing pressure over the closing stretch closing with an island green par 3 and a very long uphill par 5 the length of a snaking stream to a raised green defended by water – into the prevailing wind. Finesse as well as strength will be required for the finish of The

✈️ Dubai. Exit airport following Airport Road (signs for Al Rashidiya) for approximately 5km, after which turn right onto Emirates Road freeway (direction Abu Dhabi / Jebel Ali). After approximately 27km, having passed Arabian Ranches estate interchange on left hand side, continue straight over at Sports City roundabout on Emirates Road (signposted Abu Dhabi / Jebel Ali). After a further 8km, perform a 'U-turn' at the next large roundabout (Green Community roundabout) now heading back on Emirates Road (signposted Dubai). Follow signs to Jumeirah Golf Estates, which is 1.5km on the right hand side. N.B. Roadworks and development may result in this becoming inaccurate, so refer also to club website.
