An extremely hilly site overlooked by some housing in attractive mountain scenery yields a mixed batch of holes: what comes down has also to go up, unfortunately. Nevertheless, there are some good holes both up- and down-hill, often with difficult, small greensites and challenging bunkering.

What the The Premier Guide to GOLF COURSES says Europa

A testing, dramatic course over land occasionally extreme for resort golf. Both loops of 9 feature holes running along and over ravines of the Rio Ojén. Robinson's trademark large splashes of mainly edge-of-play bunkering add visual character. Fairways generally wider and greens larger than on the other two courses. Buggies and a good supply of balls essential.

What the The Premier Guide to GOLF COURSES says Asia

This slightly cheeky hillside course overlooked by some housing is perhaps La Cala's most characterful; it is also the narrowest: you may lose balls, but the walk is marginally less arduous. The slopes around the mainly small greensites are often as hazardous as the spectacular bunkering. Some water too.
